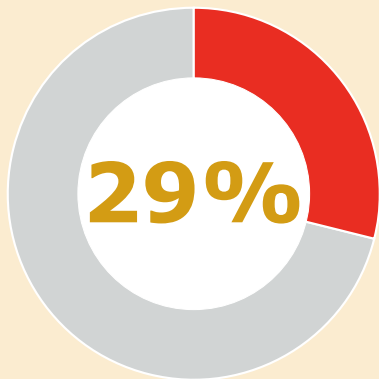
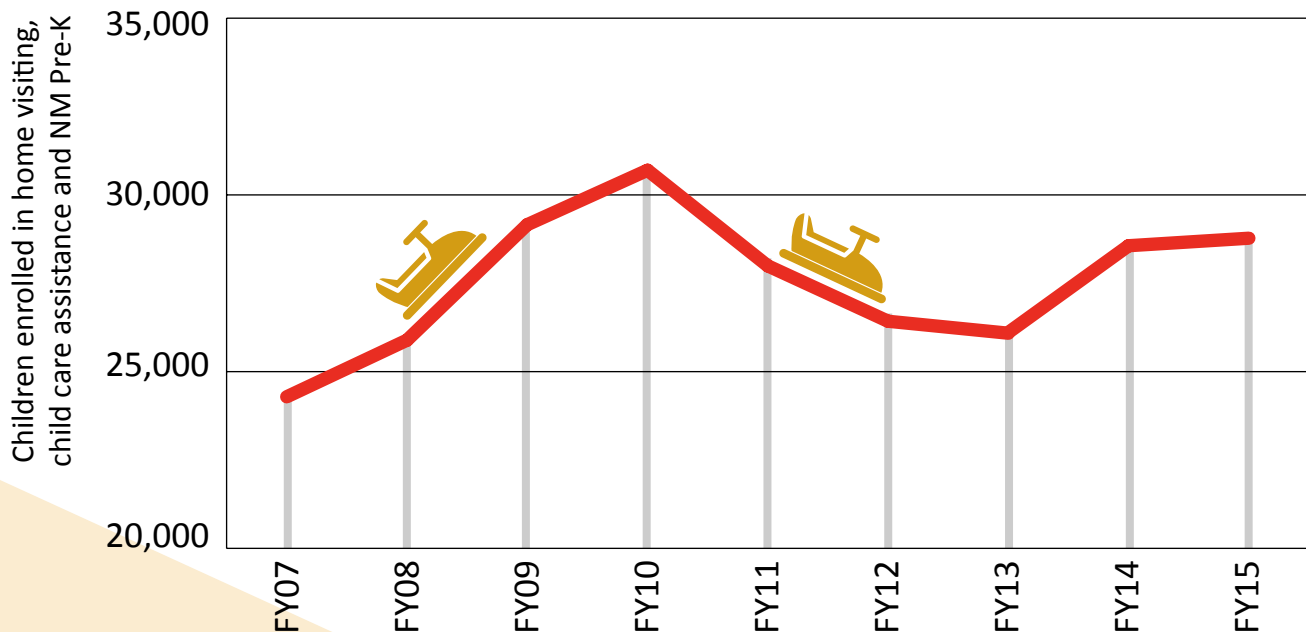


# Enrollment in early childhood programs has been a bad roller-coaster ride

Enrollment in state-funded home visiting, child care assistance, and pre-K fell from FY10 to FY13. We're only now nearing FY10 enrollment levels.



Enrollment in child care assistance alone is almost 30% lower than in FY10.

That means more than 7,000 families have lost access to a safe place to leave their kids while they work, look for work, or attend school.
